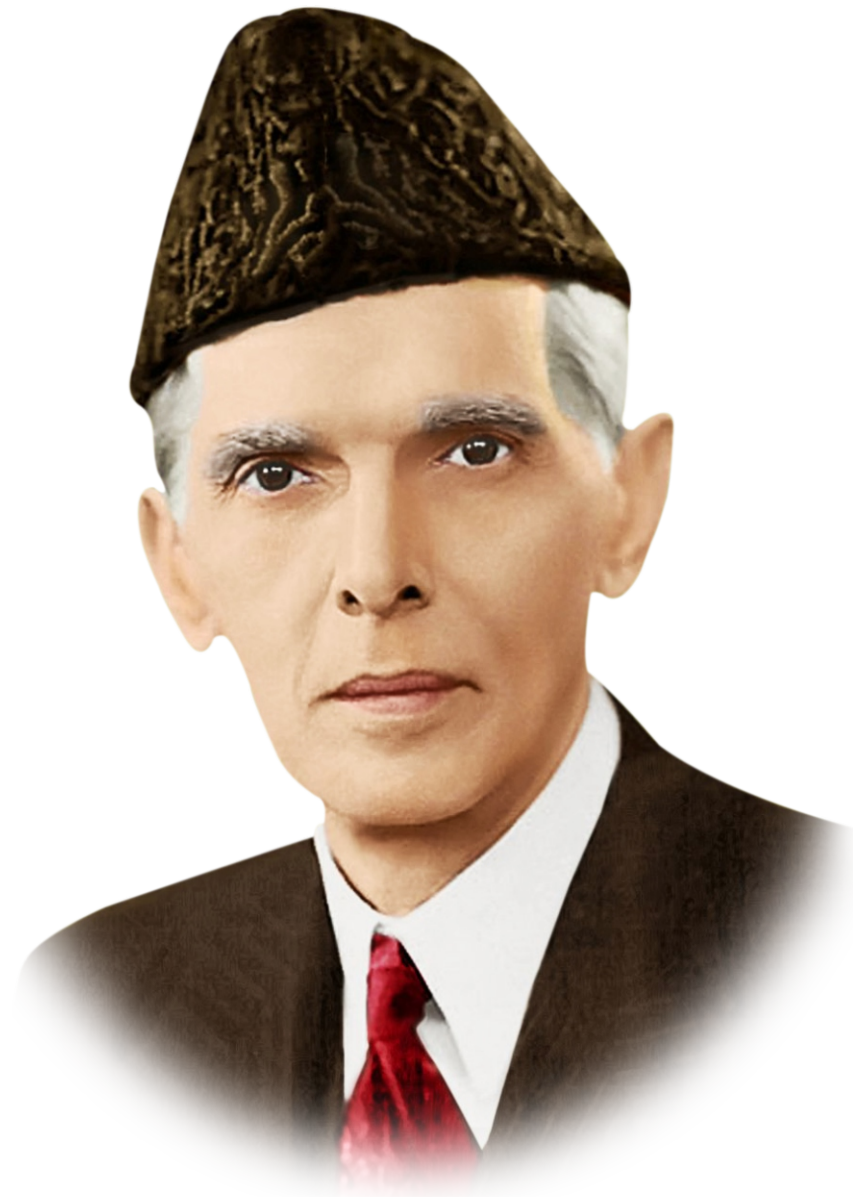

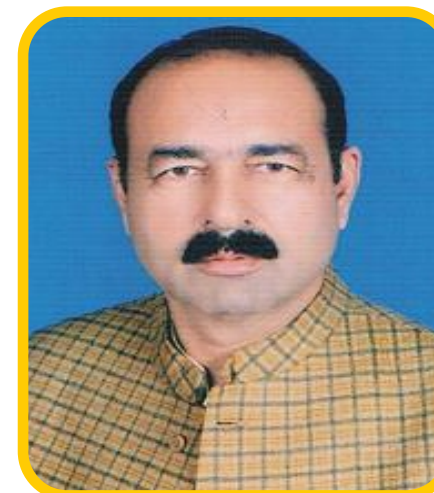

The Role of the Chamber of Commerce

The concept of Chamber of Commerce a historical institution that originated in medieval Europe holds a significant place in the evolution of trade and industry. The first Chamber was established in March, France, in 1599, marking the beginning of a legacy that continues today. These local organizations, initially formed by merchants to advocate for their interests and manage trade related matters have since spread across Europe and North America, mirroring the growth of trade and industry during the Industrial Revolution. The New York City Chamber Of Commerce, founded in 1768, is a testament to this enduring legacy. Today, Chambers of Commerce exist globally at various levels, are integral to business communities, and provide multiple services.

Chambers of Commerce and Industry, with their diverse objectives, play a crucial role in shaping economic policies. They represent business interests to governments, advocating for policies that promote economic growth and reduce regulatory burdens. This proactive role empowers businesses and entrepreneurs, fostering a conducive business environment. Chambers also facilitate networking among businesses offer resources such as business counseling, training programmers, and access to market research, and promote economic development by attracting new businesses and supporting local entrepreneurship. They keep members informed about relevant developments, provide mediation and arbitration services for business disputes, and act as neutral parties in conflicts. Chambers of Commerce significantly impact economic growth by supporting local businesses, fostering a conducive business environment, and advocating for favorable policies. They contribute to community development through various local projects and play a crucial role facilitating global trade by providing certifications; 'fostering international business relationships, and supporting exporters and importers. In Pakistan, the concept of chambers of commerce dates back to the British colonial era, with various trade Associations Chambers active before the 1947 partition. Post independence Pakistan inherited a few existing Chambers which were crucial in supporting the developing country's economic frame work. The Karachi Chamber of Commerce and industry (KCCI), established in 1959, is one of the oldest and most prominent Chambers, representing the business community of Karachi. The Lahore Chamber of Commerce and Industry (LCCI), established in 1923, continued its operations post independence serving business in Punjab. Over the years, numerous chambers have been established across Pakistan, catering to the need of businesses in various regions and sectors. The Federation of Pakistan Chamber of Commerce and Industry (FPCCI), formed in 1950, serves as the apex body representing with the government and other stakeholders on behalf of the business community

The key milestones in Pakistan's Chambers of Commerce history include the establishment of several Chambers and Trade Associations in the early post-independence decades, focusing on rebuilding the economy. In the 1970s and 1980s, these Chambers were pivotal in advocating for economic reforms and industrial growth. The globalisation of trade and the liberalization of Pakistan's economy in the 1990s brought new challenges and opportunities, leading chambers to expand their services and support to members. In recent years, efforts have been made to promote entrepreneurship, innovation. and international trade, addressing issues such as energy shortage, infrastructure development, regulatory reforms.

"Main Features of Jhang-----The Land of love;

Presently Jhang, the land of love, beauty, singing peasants, folk dances and dancing horses, which has been irrigated by the "moon-waters" for centuries. Jhang is presently consisting of 3 towns, old Jhang city, Maghiana and newly built Satellite Town. All three towns are interlinked with roads

The soil of Jhang district is suitable for almost all main and major crops like wheat, rice, Sugarcane, gram, all sorts of pulses and oil seeds, Dairy Farms, Jawar, Bajra, Maize and of fodder.

Industry:

Sugar, Cotton and wool are the major industries of the district. There are about 44 large industrial units in the district including four sugar mills, 9 textile units, one Govt woolen cum training centre, 7 woolen units when other large units include chemical food products and engineering work etc.

There are 1967 small industrial units in the district. Jhang is a great market of raw wool, wool work, wood carving, and copper in laid work, furniture & masonry. Jhang has largest number of power looms after Faisalabd, which is known to be Manchester of Pakistan. More than two hundreds of Rice Mills. Majority of Industry is agro based.

Jhang - The Cosmopolitan!

Recent economic literature strongly suggests that outward-oriented economies with sound trade, investment and export systems have achieved better development results than have inward-oriented economies. Export is a key to strengthen any capitalistic economy. Next war will be in the field of economies not in battle field. So better participation in international market is the need of the day. Especially the non-traditional and cultural items like embroidered cloths, handicrafts and wooden furniture. Jhang has blessed with all above exportable. If Sialkot has an edge of sports goods, the same is the case with Jhang as domination on Furniture items and hand-made embroidery. There is no question as if Jhang stand shoulder to shoulder with Sialkot, if proper facilities and export orientation be provided to Jhang Business activities in District Jhang have picked up considerably in the recent past. Businesses have experienced an increase in return and Businessmen have found some good investing opportunities. Jhang is advantageous in for various types of businesses. Land is cheap, skilled labour is cheap and opportunities are wide open. Here you may find milk plants and sugar mills, textile mills etc. Shakarganj Mills Ltd, Ramzan Sugar Mill, Lalian Sugar Mill etc.

An investor can easily invest money in various areas of crafts and agriculture. In recently there are cotton factories, Oil Mills and small level enterprises dealing in wooden craftsmanship which are good prospects for exports, many other small businesses are also thriving to make their name and carve their share in national and international goods.

There are generally two crops in a year, Rabi and Kharif. Rabi crop is followed by Kharif crop. This system is locally known as "Harri" and "Sawani". Sugarcane, Cotton, Wheat, Bajra, Maize and Rice are the common Rabi and Kharif crops. Rice and Wheat are grown all over the district, usually. Maize is the staple kharif crop; potato cultivation has also made considerable progress. Vegetables and Fruits approximately of all kinds are also grown throughout the district. The main Rabi crops are wheat and barley, while maize and bajra are grown as Kharif crops. Due to favourable conditions for agriculture, people of this district do take interest in crop husbandry.



Handicrafts in Jhang !

Jhang is famous for a lot of handicrafts mastered by the skilled Jhangvian artists and artisans. Embroidered Shawls

The Embroidered shawls are more an art form than a piece of garment. The intricate patterns and colorful ideas put in by the women of Jhang are loved throughout the world. These shawls come in all shades and design. These Pashmina shawls are best in quality and art work. The stitches used are simple stem, chain and darn. Lovely floral, faunal, bird and almond motifs in imaginative color combinations, perfected over centuries are the hallmark of Jhang Shawls.

Woodworks

Intricate fascinating wood carving in Arabesque or "Jali" has for long been associated with Muslim culture. Chiniot is the heaven of all woodworks. The warm and soft quality of wood enabled the carpenters to exhibit beautiful craftsmanship. Artifacts such as wooden screens, tables, chests, boxes, and a host of other articles are of international renown. The design used are floral and fruit ensembles, almond and mango motifs

Zaarban (Nara) and Paranda Making

It is another one of Jhang's traditional craft in which women artisans are engaged. Zaarban (Nara) is usually a webbed lace measuring about 2 meters in length used for stringing pyjamas. The paranda is a three strand, colorful item edged with pom-poms, beads and sequins. It is used by women adorn their hair and enhance its length and beauty.

Executive Summary

Jhang has been left behind in economic progress. Jhang has always been negatively portrayed across the world, as a region where sectarianism, fanaticism infiltrates. That's why, the international buyers are always been frightened to come in Jhang for placement of their demands and the entrepreneurs of small and cottage industry of Jhang are forced to sell their commodities to the buyers based in Lahore, who further export it to international buyers at the rates many-times more than the payments made to the businessmen in Jhang. If that state of affairs continues then all efforts for promotion of industrial activities would be baseless. The scene that reflects the uncertainty and the anxiety behind Jhang's image of bottomless abundance must be redressed through progressive campaign to boost the exports.

The basic principle reason for this growing disconnect between the evolving global market structure and our export performance is the erosion of the competitiveness of Pakistan's traditional exports in general and the country's weakness in diversifying its product and market mix and more importantly the lack in proper presentation of our traditional items like carpets, rugs, handicrafts and furniture etc.

Jhang Chamber of Commerce & Industry being representative of business community of Jhang sought attention to this grim situation. We are intended to establish an Export Resource and Training Centre with the help and financial grant from Federal Government, to encounter all the above obstacles.

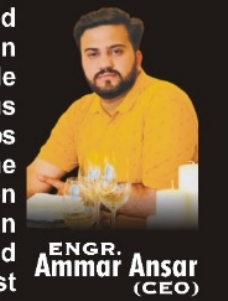
